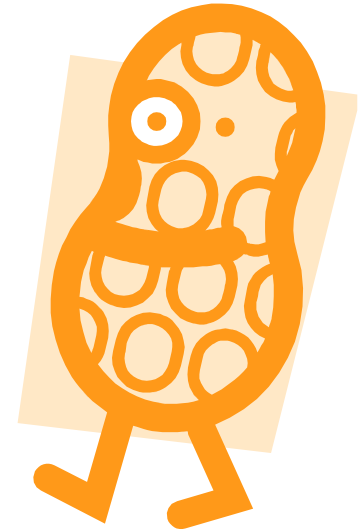

- E-Advising and the Student Education Plan (SEP) was added to WebAdvisor school year 2011/2012, as an initiative for Student Success.
- WebAdvisor is the portal for electronic academic records and resources accessible by students and advisors.
