#### Sequential model



- Initial enrollment of students into basic skills classes
- Transition into vocational programs only when a high level of competency is reached

**Concurrent Model** 



Simultaneous basic skills instruction and vocational instruction without instructional coordination

#### **Coordinated Model**



- Basic skills and vocational instructors plan content and sequencing of instruction together and share feedback of student progress and needs
- Typically incorporates a split day of basic skills and technical instruction

#### **Integrated Model**



- Concurrent basic and technical instruction
- Content and skills development woven together throughout training




## Why Develop Integrated Programs?

# Integrated Career Pathway Model



#### S.A.V.E. EMT Student Success Outcomes

Supporting Adults Through Vocational Education EMT Program



- Retention Rates increased from 50% to 85%
- 81% Job Placement Rate
- Increased Access to Career Pathway for 30% of class participants
- 40% more participants entering the field of EMT

## S.A.V.E. Admissions

#### Minimum Vestibule requirements:

- 21 years+ with high school or GED diploma
- 8+ grade reading level on TABE
- Driver's license
- Work eligible



# What is Contextualized Instruction at LaGuardia?

The development of a student's reading, writing, communication and math skills using instructional materials and content from a specific workforce sector, academic discipline or career track.

## **Contextualized Vestibule**

- Evaluate persistence & academic readiness
- Introduce training content
- Develop study strategies



- Build Soft Skills; teamwork, communication
- Establish Academic Routines
