



Campus Completion Plans

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House Bill 59 called for each public college and university to submit a campus completion plan that was approved by their board of trustees to the Chancellor by June 30, 2014. The legislation further states that these plans are to be updated every two years. Completion plans provide a continuous improvement framework that can allow campuses to identify and implement strategies to increase the number and percentage of students earning meaningful postsecondary credentials. 

ODHE NAMES DR. TOM SUDKAMP AS NEW VICE CHANCELLOR OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS





Ohio Department of Higher Education Names Sudkamp as Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs

The Ohio Department of Higher Education (ODHE) has named Dr. Thomas Sudkamp as its new Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs, effective January 11, 2021. Dr. Sudkamp fills the role vacated by Dr. Stephanie Davidson, who retired at the end of 2020 after more than 33 years of service in education, including 13 years with ODHE.

Dr. Sudkamp has served ODHE since 2019 as the executive director of the Ohio Strong Start to Finish program, a collaboration of 30 public community colleges and universities designed to increase the number of students who complete gateway mathematics and English courses in their first year of study. Prior to that, he served in various academic leadership roles over more than three decades in higher education, most recently as provost and vice president for curriculum and instruction at Wright State University.

"I am pleased with the wealth of experience and the breadth of knowledge that Dr. amp brings to this position," said Chancellor Randy Gardner. "His familiarity with trong Start to Finish program and established relationships with Ohio's colleges ne critical issues of postsecondary access, student success, and higher education-procealignment will continue to be prioritized under Tom's leadership."
