Six things we've **learned** from the Ohio Community Colleges and the Ohio Success Center



1. Substantial improvement requires reforms with sufficient breadth and depth.
2. Whole-college change requires broad engagement and sustained commitment.
3. Improvement on long-term student outcomes is unlikely without gains on nearer term outcomes.
4. To improve overall while also increasing equitable outcomes, reforms must be universal and personalized.
5. To broaden the benefits of dual enrollment, policies, practices, and mindsets matter.
6. Scaling whole-college reforms within a college is strengthened by a statewide focus on student success.
