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# SUCCESS OVER THE PAST DECADE

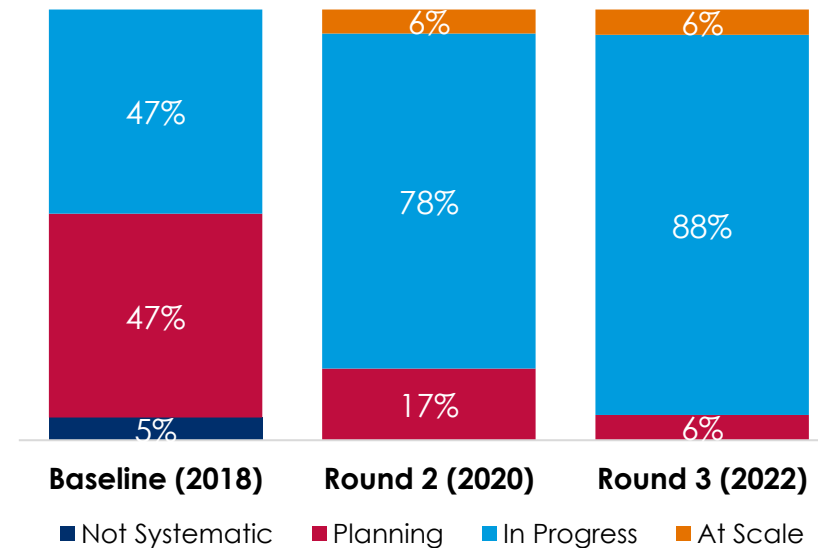


Since 2013, nearly **200,000 associate degrees and 1-year certificates** have been awarded...

... and the **three-year graduation rate** has nearly **tripled** from 9% to 25%

**Guided pathways implementation has doubled since 2018,** with 94% of colleges scaling in progress or at scale.

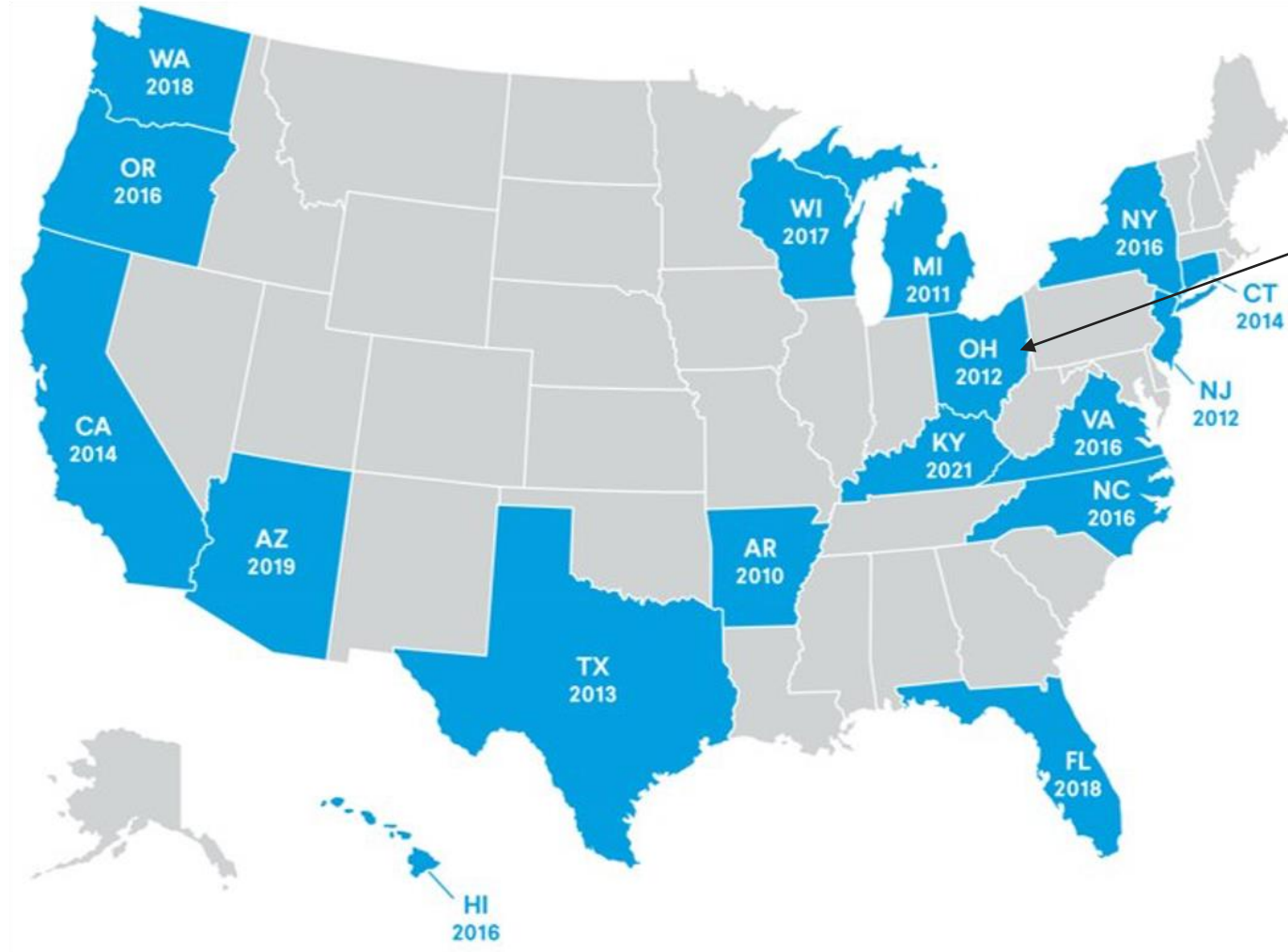

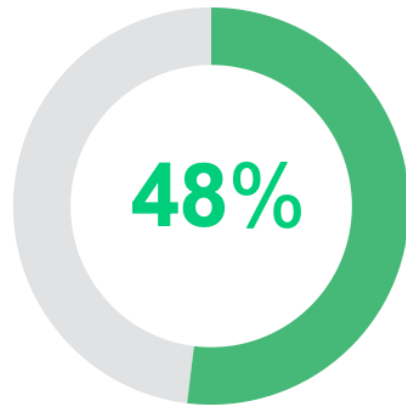

# National scale

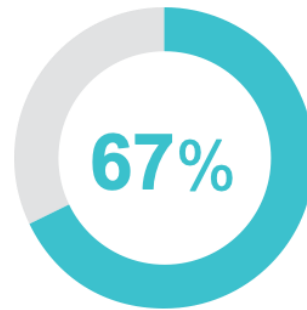
JFF launched the Network in 2012. Today, it spans 17 states and serves **nearly half** of public community colleges in the U.S.

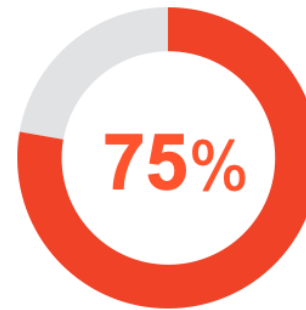

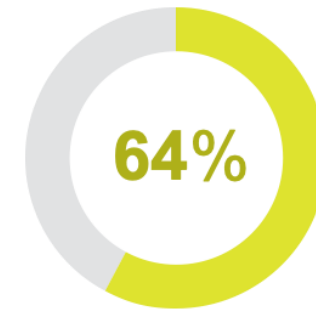

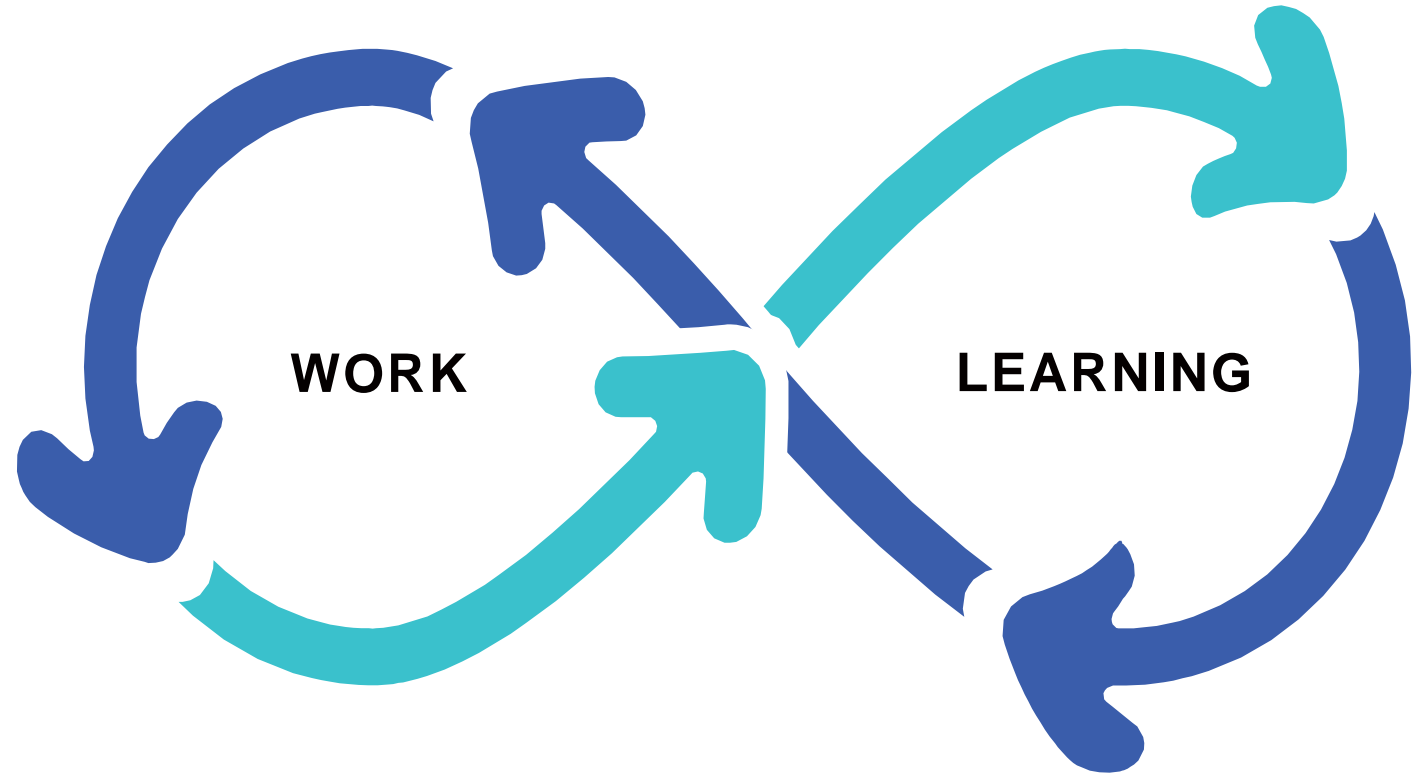
## Employers and Workforce Partners

Designed for adults

Built in partnership with industry and employers

Meets an immediate talent need

Short-term, skills-based training

On-ramps through CBOs and bridges from ABE

Often non-credit or CTE programs

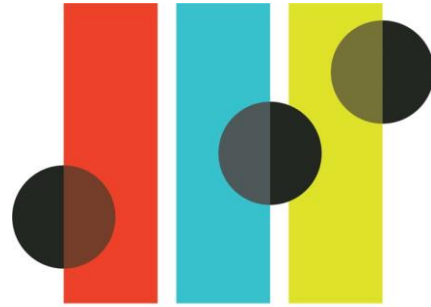
