

# Ohio's Statewide Community College Cohorts

Over 800 faculty and staff from all 23 public community colleges across Ohio have engaged in an ACUE Course since Fall 2020

- 500 Ohio community college faculty have earned a certificate in ACUE's Effective Teaching Practice Framework.
- 232 faculty and staff have earned a certificate in Inclusive Teaching for Equitable Learning (ITEL) or Fostering a Culture of Belonging (FCB.)





### **Cincinnati State**

- Early Adopter (Since 2020)
- Selected for a special initiative funded by The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation
- 68 unique faculty course takers have engaged in ACUE programs, with 48 having earned the Effective Online Teaching Practices designation
- Approximately 60% of participants FT faculty and 40% PT





Biggest Takeaway: It's important to convey to students that getting it wrong is part of learning and to clearly convey the purpose of assignments and activities. Promoting a growth mindset and maintaining transparent course design can be tremendously motivating, and motivation is one of the core challenges of post-pandemic education.





#### 1. ENGAGEMENT



87% of faculty would recommend the ACUE course to a colleague.



92% of faculty report modules were helpful in refining their teaching practice.



96% of faculty found the content relevant to their work.



#### 2. LEARNING


