STUDENT SUCCESS LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

WHAT?

The Student Success Leadership Institutes (SSLI) are two-day events in February (virtual) and September (in-person) each year for 250 Ohio community college professionals to give college teams the opportunity to hear from national and state experts, share model practices from the campus level, engage with colleagues, and plan and reflect on progress with scaling student success reforms.

Each college sends an average of 12 people, often including the president, chief academic officer, chief financial officer, and chief student affairs officer, as well as representatives from: institutional research, academic affairs, advising, student services, and workforce development.
